Current project 2025-2028:

"Cutting Carbon – Promoting Biochar for Climate Change Mitigation". This EUKI co-financed project is taking place in Sicily, Croatia and North-Macedonia and focuses on carbon sequestration through the introduction of biochar into the soil, which was previously produced from tree cuttings. Fruit growers shall become climate protectors! A greening campaign promotes tree plantings and green roofs in town. Within a large-scale environmental education work for school children, we conduct a comparative Citizen Science study for trees in different substrates.

Requirements: Participation of your university in an Erasmus+ internship programme. You should be flexible, open-minded, adaptable and willing to participate in all upcoming work. You need to respect the different mentality of the host country. We expect self-initiative and the ability to work independently as well as in a team. Your worktime will be shared between the general teamwork, e.g. olive harvesting or school visits, and your possible individual study. Together with you and your university tutor, we will discuss your thesis topic and deliver logistic support.

It would be helpful to already know some Italian; English skills are necessary. The willingness to follow instructions from Giacche Verdi and currently applicable rules is indispensable.
